Please use your **CUSTOMER ID NUMBER** located on your invoice under the **SHIP TO** address. On your monthly statement the same number appears under the date as **ACCOUNT NUMBER**. (If you do not have an account number, you will receive one with your first invoice.)

PRINT in **BLUE** or **BLACK INK**. Send the original, not the copy.

SHIPMENTS: We ship U.P.S. Ground unless you request another way. There is no credit on shortages if they are not reported within 30 days. Check your shipment against your packing slip. Outside the United States, we ship by a reasonable surface transportation.

REMITTANCES: The **COST LIST** shows costs of materials for schools and individuals. Outside the United States, you must make payment in United States dollars. Shipping and handling costs are not included in the costs of materials. If you have a credit account with us, these will be added to your bill. Do not include payment with your order. If you do not have a credit account with us, send a certified check or money order for the cost of materials plus 10% to cover handling and shipping. If handling and shipping are greater than 10%, you will be billed for the balance due. Materials will not be sent C.O.D., except through special arrangement that involves additional charges.

RETURNS AND ADJUSTMENTS OR BOTH

A Carden Nursery School Program

Does your school begin with four-year-old children?

Youngsters beginning Carden should not miss the key elements of the Carden THREE-YEAR-OLD PROGRAM.

Present *Ask Mr. Bear* and *Good Night Moon* according to the procedures of *The Three-year-old Program*, Parts 1 and 2.

Let them enjoy all of *Little Rhymes for Little People*.

They do the work of *Numbers for the Three-Year-Old Child* first. Then they begin arithmetic for the FOUR-YEAR-OLD PROGRAM.

Mae Carden believed that a basic education was more than reading, writing, and arithmetic. The arts—including paintings and music—are vital.

Schools beginning with four-year olds should begin with the selections of art appreciation for the three-year olds.

Remember that Mae Carden began with music. *Going to the Zoo* and *Up, Up, Down, Down* are among the songs children will enjoy. They first appear in *The Three-year-old Program, Part 2*.

Advanced students may start the first reader, *Class Book 4*, with *Ne-qua-la and the Eagles* (pages 17-17b). The teacher uses *0404* and *0406* when teaching this story.

Then students do Parts III-V (pages 47-101), and the teacher uses *0404* and *0407*. Students benefit from lessons in rhythmic reading and writing summaries.

After finishing their work with the first reader, they begin the second (0485). They complete it in Grade 5.

Some students may begin the year with *Intermediate Class Book*.
